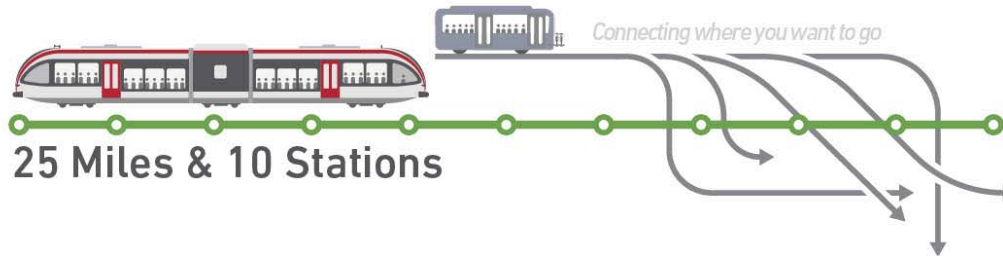


GREEN LINE *at a glance*

METRO RAIL

The Green Line would connect Downtown Austin to Colony Park with future extensions to Manor and Elgin.



» GREEN LINE BENEFITS

The Green Line is proposed along Capital Metro's existing freight line between Downtown Austin to Colony Park, with future extensions to Manor and Elgin. Improvements would include developing transit stations along the corridor that would provide great places to connect the community to efficient, reliable transit.

Unique opportunities for housing.

The proposed Green Line corridor could provide transit opportunities to equity households along the corridor.

Increased access to jobs and services.

The proposed Green Line could provide more households with transit as an option to travel to jobs and services within Central Austin and beyond. The Green Line would provide connectivity to the Red Line, other potential high-capacity corridors and Capital Metro's high-frequency bus network.

» GREEN LINE FACTS

The first phase will be eight miles long to Colony Park and includes seven stations. The next phases could add an additional 17 miles and three more stations.

Commuter rail would operate more frequently and move people quickly and efficiently.
